ConditionCare is an Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield (Anthem) program that offers support to people with the following conditions:

- Asthma
- Diabetes
- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)
- Congestive heart failure (CHF)
- Coronary artery disease (CAD)

If you have one of these health issues, call 1-866-596-9812 to sign up.

Members who use ConditionCare can also save on covered medical services and prescription drugs that help manage their condition. Your covered family members may use ConditionCare, too.

Future Moms

If you're having or planning to have a baby, take advantage of Anthem's Future Moms program. This resource gives you telephone access to a registered nurse, 24/7, for pregnancy-related questions and support after delivery. You'll also receive educational materials to help you understand the changes your body and developing baby are going through.

Flu shots

Anthem and the MEA Benefits Trust program work with local providers or your school's health services to provide you with annual flu shot clinics.

When you join ConditionCare, you'll earn a \$100 gift card from one of more than 200 major retailers. Work with your nurse coach to manage your condition. After you graduate from the program, you'll get another \$100 gift card.

You'll also receive valuable gift cards when you sign up in Future Moms. Choose a \$100 gift card from hundreds of retailers each time you complete a phone assessment with a Future Moms nurse: one during your first trimester, another during your second trimester and a third after your baby is born. That's up to \$300 in gift cards!

* Members must be age 18 or older to qualify for program rewards.

Onlife Health wellness program*

With Onlife Health, you can earn and redeem points for prepaid debit cards by getting screenings, working with a health coach and completing challenges and other activities.

Employees, retirees, spouses/domestic partners and dependents age 18+ are eligible, if covered under the MEABT health plan. To learn more:

- 2. Choose **Get Started** and log in with key code "MEABT."
- 3. Follow the directions to create your username and password. You'll need them whenever you access the site.
