## **Podcasting Guide Sheet**

- 1. Turn on computer and log in.
- 2. Plug in headset. Open System Preferences (under blue apple). Open Sound. Make sure Plantronics Headset is highlighted under both Output and Input. Do sound check using Input. **Note:** you will get no response if the mute button on the headset chord is lit.
- 3. Open Garage Band. Double click on "Create New Podcast Episode." You will be asked to save your file. Please check with your instructor for the correct naming scheme.
- 4. Delete (apple key + delete) all tracks except Male or Female Voice. Click on the appropriate track.
- 5. Record using red record button. To stop recording, use the space bar.
- 6. To listen to your recording, press "z" to return to the beginning of the track, then press the play button.
- 7. When you are satisfied with your recording, you are ready to export it. Go to Share > Export to Disk. Be sure Compress is checked. Compress using MP3 Encoder and Audio Settings: High Quality. Click Export. Be sure Hide Extension is Unchecked. Save to the Music folder.
- 8. You are now ready to have your file transferred to an external drive.
- 9. When you are sure that your file is safely stored on your teacher's computer, you may delete your podcasting file from your computer.

## Tips:

- 1. Announce the title of your reading at the beginning of your recording.
- 2. **Always eject the external drive** before removing it from the computer (failure to do so could damage data—yours and that of other students—on the external drive).
- 3. Keep microphone several inches away from your mouth to minimize popping sounds on your recording.
- 4. During the recording session, please do not talk with other students; background noise needs to be kept to a minimum.
- 5. If you need to move around, first detach the headsets from the computer to prevent damage to the USB plug and port.
